CHURCH CAMPUS OVERVIEW

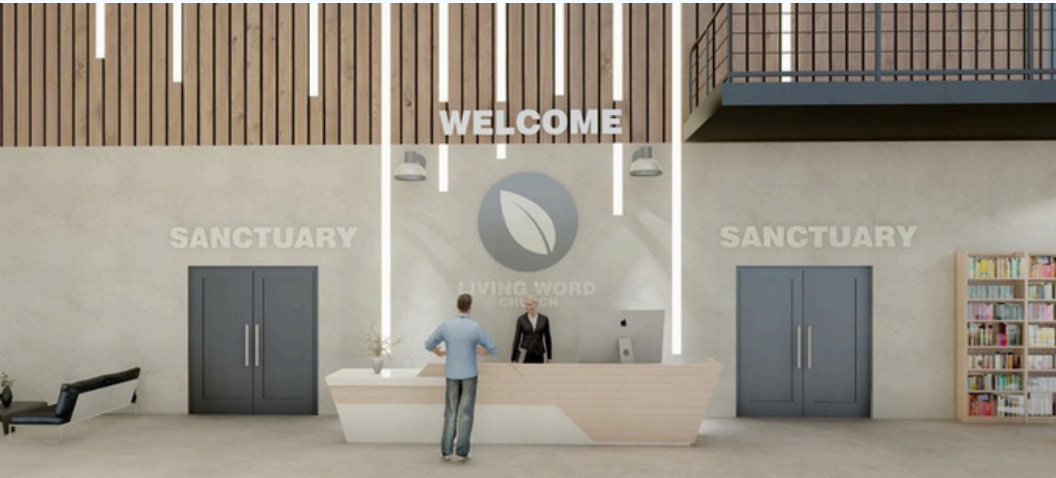
The proposed Living Word campus is designed as an integrated environment supporting worship, education, and daily ministry.

LW KIDS & YOUTH CENTER

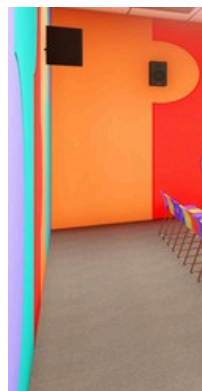
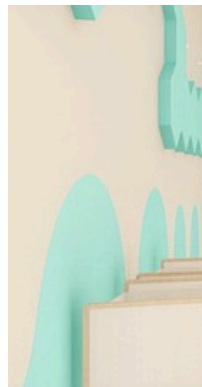
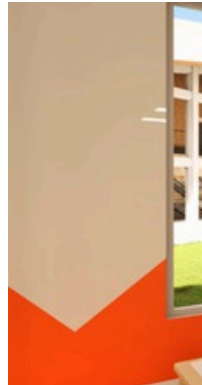
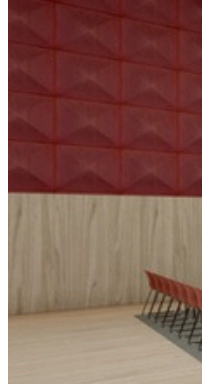
AUDITORIUM / NURSERY / CAFE

"EVERYTHING STARTED CHANGING THE MOMENT WE DECIDED TO OBEY GOD."

At the time, we owned a two-family home in Weymouth. I had lost my job due to an injury, and then without warning, our tenants stopped paying rent. What began as a frustrating situation quickly spiraled into a full financial crisis. As we pursued legal action, we fell further and further behind on our mortgage. Eventually, we received a foreclosure notice.

The stress was overwhelming.

It was during that season that Legacy Month came around. Financially, it made absolutely no sense for us to give. We were behind. We were in crisis. We were just trying to survive. But as we prayed about making a pledge to the Legacy Foundation, I felt God put a specific number on my heart. It wasn't a small number, especially given what we were facing. Everything in the natural said, "This is not smart."

But we chose to obey.

Shortly after deciding to make that pledge, we were watching the 700 Club one day when I hit pause to take a phone call. During that conversation, I was explaining our foreclosure situation and how far behind we had fallen. As we talked, I grabbed a calculator and began adding everything up.

When I reached the final number, my heart sank. We were \$22,000 behind. It felt impossible.

The conversation ended. I hung up the phone, pressed play on the 700 Club, and within moments Pat Robertson began sharing a word of knowledge. He said that someone needed \$22,000 and that God was providing it.

My jaw hit the floor! I had just calculated that number only moments earlier. In that instant, the fear lifted. The anxiety broke. It was replaced with faith and a deep peace that only God could give. He saw us. He was getting involved. And we knew He could do it.

Provision began coming together in ways we could never have orchestrated. By the end of the month, the full \$22,000 had come in, and we were able to remove our home from foreclosure.

And that's not the end of the story! Now, after being Legacy partners for over 6 years, we've sold the Weymouth property for a great profit. We've been able to purchase a vacation home in New Hampshire that blesses our family immensely. Now we're believing God for our dream home...close to Living Word!

Looking back, we can clearly see that our breakthrough didn't start when the money came in; it started when we chose to obey. The confirmation came later. The provision followed. There truly is something powerful on the other side of obedience!

I returned to Living Word in September of 2022, and in February 2023 I attended my first Legacy service. As Pastor Mike began sharing, I was overwhelmed with emotion. I felt such a strong stirring in my heart that I could hardly explain it.

Pastor Mike spoke about the Shunammite woman who prepared a room for the man of God and placed the things of God first. Because of her faithfulness, God blessed her with something money could never buy. As I listened, I felt strongly that I needed to be part of Legacy. For the first time, I felt like I had something meaningful and tangible that I could invest in for my future.

I prayed and asked the Holy Spirit to give me a number to pledge. When I sensed the amount, I was surprised and even questioned it. I set it aside for a short time. About a week later, while driving, the Legacy pledge came back to my mind along with a thought to total how much money I had spent on a certain hobby. When I added it up, it matched exactly the number I felt the Holy Spirit had given me. At that moment, I knew I needed to step out in faith.

I made my pledge and set up weekly giving. Soon after, my mindset began to change. I started receiving ideas for generating income and managing my finances differently. Even though my income had not dramatically increased at first, I saw God's provision in ways that did not make sense naturally. Within nine months, I was on track to be debt-free.

By the following Legacy season, my IRS debt was completely paid off, along with a \$12,000 personal loan and my car loan. I also received two raises at work during that time. It was clear that God was moving in my life.

Before this, I had prayed and asked God to give me the heart of a giver. I also thought about my daughter and future generations who will be part of this church. Proverbs says that a good person leaves an inheritance for their children's children. I saw my Legacy commitment as part of that inheritance. If you feel God stirring your heart to give but fear is holding you back, I understand that feeling. I experienced it too. My encouragement is simple — step out in faith.

After sixteen years of marriage, we can honestly say that the last four have been the best years of our lives. That doesn't mean the first twelve lacked love, we have always loved each other deeply. Like most couples, we walked through seasons of highs and lows: moments of great joy, moments of tension, and seasons of trying to figure things out as we went.

But something shifted in these recent years. We truly became one, choosing to trust God in a new and deeper way, and that decision changed everything.

For years, we tithed inconsistently. If we had extra that week, we gave. Sometimes it was \$25, sometimes \$50. We meant well, but our giving was based on what felt comfortable in the moment. We often found ourselves financially strained, bank accounts dipping into the negative and stress creeping into our days.

Then we made a decision that felt both bold and intimidating: To faithfully give 10 percent of our income and to give to the Legacy Foundation beyond that. It wasn't easy, change rarely is. We wondered how we would make it work and questioned whether we could afford to give that way.

We chose obedience over fear.

What followed surprised us. Our account stopped going negative. Bills were paid. Opportunities opened. The strain we had grown used to began to lift. We stopped managing everything in our own strength and began trusting God fully with our finances.

The act of giving started a chain reaction of more change in our lives. We found the strength to do things that were once hard for us. We committed to praying together every night as a couple. That simple first step of giving transformed our marriage in ways we never expected. Our hearts softened, our decisions became unified, and all of this brought us so much closer.

Looking back, the greatest blessing hasn't just been financial stability, it has been oneness. We made the choice to trust God together, and because of it we are more connected, and more confident in the direction of our lives than ever before.

Sixteen years in, we are still growing, but now we are growing together and these truly have been the best years yet.
